In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 112 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988), and in accordance with the Government of India Notification S.O.1522(E), dated 6th April, 2018 published in the Gazette of India Extraordinary No.1377 dated 6th April, 2018, Government of Kerala have refixed the maximum speed that can be allowed for different type of vehicles in various roads in the State vide notification issued under G.O.(P) No.15/2023/Tran. dated 23rd June, 2023 and published as S.R.O. No.707/2023 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No.2108 dated 23rd June, 2023.

WHEREAS, the Regional Officer, National Highways Authority of India (Kerala) has informed that all six/four lane roads developed under NHAI in Kerala with a maximum speed of 100 kmph are notfully access controlled. Hence refixing of traffic sign boards with a maximum speed of 110 kmph/95 kmph is not permitted by Ministry of Road Transport & Highways for M1, M2 & M3 category vehicles. It has been requested to review the notification issued in line of the Central Government notification.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Government of Kerala have decided to modify the notification issued under G.O.(P) No.15/2023/Tran. dated 23rd June, 2023 and published as S.R.O. No.707/2023 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No.2108 dated 23rd June, 2023, as follows,- in the TABLE, in column (3), in the entry - National Highway-Sixlane & above divided carriage way, against serial number 1, the speed of M1 category vehicles is refixed as 100 kmph and against serial number 2 the speed of M2 & M3 category vehicles is refixed as 90 kmph.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

Speed limit of various vehicles plying on the road in the State is prescribed vide G.O.(P) No.15/2023-Trans. dated 23rd June, 2023 and published as S.R.O.No.707/2023 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary no. 2108 dated, 23rd June, 2023. The Regional Officer, National Highways Authority of India (Kerala) has informed that all six/four lane roads developed under National Highways Authority of India inKerala with a maximum speed of 100 kmph are not fully access controlled. Hence refixing of traffic sign boards with a maximum speed of 110 kmph/95 kmph is not permitted by Ministry of Road Transportand Highways for M1, M2 & M3 category vehicles.

The Government have decided to refix the speed of M1 category vehicles, M2 & M3 category vehicles in National Highway-Six lane & above roads in the notification issued under G.O.(P) No.15/2023/Tran. dated 23rd June, 2023 and published as S.R.O. No.707/2023 in theKerala Gazette Extraordinary No.2108 dated 23rd June, 2023.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
