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**Guidelines for Electric Vehicles & E Mobility for implementing
Policy on E Vehicles**

I INFRASTRUCTURE

1. Establishment of charging stations/charging points by e.vehicle manufacture
2. Every e.vehicle dealers shall be facilitate charging station in every 50 kms radius.
3. Every e.vehicle dealers shall be provide technical support for set up charging stations and charging points.
4. Sufficient number of charging points shall set up at important locations of corporation area and tourist destinations by e.vehicle dealers.
5. Availability of skilled personnels for after sales service support.
6. Residential homes also permitted to facilitate charging points in commercial aspects.
7. Battery Swapping facility to be arranged in major places of corporation limit or on every 50 kms.
8. If vehicle running on fossile fuel vehicle dealers shall establish retrofitment centres along with their service centres.
9. Ensure availability of components and spares for replacement.
10. Establish solar power stations for Power Generation for balancing the extra power utilisation.
11. Establish training and aware centres.

II Legal Frame Work

- 1 Regional Transport Authorities can notify seperate lanes and parking place for e-rickshaws in citites/major towns.
2. Replacement of vehicles shall allows only with e-vehicles.
- 3 All Regional Transport Authorities shall reserve 25% permit for e-rickshaws.
- 4 Every public/common parking shall provide charging facilityu for e.vehicles with designated parking space.
5. Parking space for every commercial building shall reserve parking space for at least two vehicle with charging point.
6. Every petrol pumps premises shall facilitat e.vehicles to park and charging.
7. Include pre-requisite condition for charging infrastructure for granting new building constructs permit.
8. Notify e-mobility zone in every major towns..
9. Permissions for retrofitment centres.
10. Instustrial & IT parks shall declare as e-mobility zone.
11. First and last mile connectivity shall be arranges with e-vehicles
12. Appoint a special officer for implementation publicity and training

III Training

Prepare training programme for all state holders with a standard schedule.

Draft Schemes for new buyers of Electric Vehicles -Auto Rickshaws & Implementation Guidelines

In pursuance of the new Electric Vehicle Policy of State Government the Motor Vehicles Department publishes the proposal of scheme to provide finance assistance to existing or new Electric Auto Rickshaws buyers in the state.

1. The Financial assistance provided by the Government is limited to Rs.30,000/- or 25% of the value of the vehicle for each Auto Rickshaws.

2. The amount so providing as subsidy to

1. An Individual

Based on Aadhar number and such amount shall be debited to beneficiaries Account number directly by the Transport Commissioner up on online application

2. Co-Operative Society

Subsidy to such number of vehicles shall be calculated and credited to the company upon the certified of Register of co-operative societies.

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1. Any person attained the age of 18 years can apply for subsidy.

2. The applicant should be domicile of Kerala.

3. Annual Income of the applicant's family should not exceeding three lakhs rupees.
4. The maximum subsidy allowable is upto Rs.30,000/- on 25% of the vehicle purchase value which ever .
5. The applicant should have own a electric auto rickshaw in his own name.
6. An individual can avail subsidy only for one vehicle.
7. The ownership or possession of the vehicle should not be transferred to changed within 2 years.
8. If the ownership was changed the owner shall repay the subsidy to Government.

II Documents to be submitted

1. Registration Certificate of Electric Auto Rickshaw
2. Front page of account Pass book of beneficiary
3. ID card with photo-issued by any competent authority of State or Central Government.

III How to apply

1. On receiving the registration number of the electric auto rickshaw the RTO should send the above details to Transport Commissioner and the Transport Commissioner will transfer the eligible amount to his account number online.
2. Transport Commissioner will sent a yearly statement to Government.

The Transport Department will review the progress of implementation in a quarterly basis.
