Subject: Verification of expired permits at the time of their renewal.

Madam/Sir,

Representations have been received by this Ministry, on the matter of renewal of permits which got expired during COVID-19 period.

- 2. It has been apprised that permit holders in few States/UTs have been asked by the respective Transport Departments to submit the original expired permits on submission of the application for renewal of permits.
- 3. While it is strongly advocated that the permit holders should keep safe the original permits; however, in some cases the same may not be available with the respective permit holders. In view of the exceptional circumstances of COVID-19 period, relaxation for cases where the applicant is unable to submit the original expired permit may be considered and in such cases, the submission of original expired permits may not be insisted upon.
- 4. Further, in case the details of the permit are to be verified, the same may be processed through Vahan/State-specific digital records in such cases.
- This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.
