No. ...../2016. – In exercise of the powers conferred by section 96 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988), the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules further to amend the Kerala Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, the same having been previously published as notification No. 2764/B2/2010/Tran dated 29<sup>th</sup> January 2016 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 270 dated 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2016 as required by sub-section (1) of section 212 of the said Act namely:-

#### RULES

- Short title and commencement. (1) These rules may be called the Kerala Motor Vehicles (2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment) Rules, 2016.
  - (2) They shall come into force on 1st July 2016.
- 2. Amendment of the rules. In the Kerala Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, in sub rule (2) of rule 280,
- (i) the words "except in the case of town and city services" shall be omitted.
- (ii) the symbol ',' after the word 'outside' shall be substituted by the symbol '.' .

## **Explanatory Note**

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

It has come to the notice of the Government that lack of shutters in city and town service causing accidents. Hence Government have decided to implement door – shutters in city and town services also.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.

# Rule 280(2) of Kerala Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989

Every door of a stage carriage shall be provided with shutters which can be opened outward from inside as well as outside (, except in the case of town and city services)\*
