Government vide the letter referred have informed that the Supreme Court Committee on Road Safety has observed that non-insurance of vehicles causes hardships to the road accident victims in obtaining compensation. It is instructed to check the vehicles periodically to see whether the owners have third party insurance cover and in case they are not covered by third party insurance, the vehicle should be detained till such time the valid insurance certificate is produced by the vehicle owner.
