ORDER

As per the GO read above, Government have revised the rates of the pollution under control certificates issued by authorised testing stations for different classes of vehicles.

The Association of Authorised Pollution Testing Stations has submitted a representation before the Government to enhance the rates of pollution under control certificates as the prevailing rates were revised before 5 years and for re-fixing the qualifications of technicians of such centres.

In this context, Government have appointed a technical committee to study the requests of the association. As per the letter read as third paper above, the technical committee submitted its report before Government.
