In the judgement in WPC No. 27011/12 filed by before the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala against the unauthorised erection of hoardings, advertisement boards, the Hon'ble High Court has directed the Transport and Road Safety Commissioner to remove Commissioner boards and hoardings in coordination with Local self advertisement Government Institutions. Hence you were directed to take all necessary steps to remove the hoardings and advertisement boards which are found to be a cause of occurrence of traffic blocks and accidents and found distractive to the drivers. You were also directed to invoke the provisions of the Kerala Road Safety Authority Act in consultation with the District Road Safety Councils. All Deputy Transport Commissioners vide reference 2nd cited, were directed to forward a compliance report in this regard in return. Except from DTC CZ II, no reply has been received so far. Hence you are once again directed to look the matter seriously and forward a compliance report without further delay.

Now vide reference 3rd cited, a lawyer notice is received in this office demanding the removal of the hoardings and flex boards in compliance with the judgements referred 1st above. In this regard you are directed to take necessary action and intimate the petitioner accordingly. A copy of the reference 3rd is enclosed.
