Sir/Madam, Rule 105 and 106 of Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 lay down specific standards for vehicles to ensure adequate visibility for the driver without simultaneously impairing the visibility of drivers coming from the opposite direction. These are very important safetyrequirements. 2. It has been brought to the notice of this Ministry that Rule 105 and 105 of Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 are not being strictly observed while registering the vehicles. The Registering Authorities have to satisfy themselves that all the requirements of the Motor Vehicles Act 1988 and Central Motor Vehicles Rules. 1989 including the above are fulfilled at the time of Registration of vehicles. 3. You are requested to issue appropriate instructions to all the enforcement agencies under your control for strict compliance of the provisions of the said rules.
