Numerous complaints are being received from many sections of people in the State that it is impossible for children and women to board buses since the height of the foot-board is not according to specifications prescribed. You are instructed to take immediate necessary action to inspect all such stage carriages and to take appropriate remedial action. The Deputy Transport Commissioners and Regional Transport Officers should take personal interest in the matter to see that stage carriages have steps according to specifications in the KMV Rules. It is further represented that emergency exits prescribed as per the recent amendments to KMV Rules cannot open out in many stage carriages since after the inspection of the vehicles ladders have been fixed to the vehicles blocking the opening of the emergency exit. The Deputy Transport Commissioners, Regional Transport Officers and Joint Regional Transport Officers are hereby instructed to take immediate action in this regard. burs faithfully.
