Subject: Central Motor Vehicles Amendept Rules, 1993.

Your attention is invited to the amendept on the Central Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Rules, 1993 notified on-26th March 1993 with reference to the "Specimen signature or thumb impression of the financier" in Form Numbers 20-34.

In this connection it is clarified that the provision of affixing specimen signature of the financiers in various Forms that been provided for the purpose of creating a permanent and non-temporable record for the RTO. Officers. As you may be aware there are a number of corporate firms who are in the business of hire purchase and leasing as well as commercial banks which are engaged in the business of hypothication. In their cases, there are frequent transfers of officials and therefore changes in signatures will be a normal feature.

I would therefore be greateful if suitable instructions are issued to the Transport Commissioners/RTO to the fact that the tallying of specimen Signatures is not to be insisted upon in the case of financiers alike corporate entitites/ Companies/ Banks.


