Sub:- Exemption from Rule 304 of KMVR' 89 - Request from V.S.S.C. - reg.

Ref:- Your letter No. V.S.GC/TOMD/ ADMN/92/607 dt. 15.7.92.

I am to invite your attention to the reference cited and to inform you that as per the proviso to Rule 407 of the Kerala Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 any order made or action taken under the repealed rules (KMV Rules 1961) shall be deemed to have been made under the corresponding provision of the newly framed rules. Since there is no inconsistency between the KMV Rules 1961 and KMV Rules 1989 with regard to the power of the State Government to exempt any goods vehicles or class of goods vehicles from the requirement of painting either fully or its front and rear portion in Highway yellow colour, the notifications issued under the repealed Rules shall be deemed to have been made under the reenacted Rules. Hence there is no need to issue a fresh notification under the reenacted Rules for the same purpose.
