Sub:- ~~Motor Vehicles Dept.~~ M.V. Act & Rules - Overall dimensions of Motor Vehicles - Registration of vehicles prior to the grant of exemption from Government - Irregularity - instructions issued -

...

Instances have come to the notice of the undersigned that Registering Authorities often register Motor Vehicles before exemption is granted by Government from the operation of rules relating to overall dimension of Motor Vehicles.

2. The Committee on subordinate legislation ^{have} also deprecated this procedure of registering the vehicles before actual exemption is granted according to rules. Registration of Motor Vehicles (which require exemption from relevant rules) before they are exempted from the operation of ~~rules~~ rules is not legally in order.

3. In the circumstances, all Registering Authorities are directed that no Motor Vehicle, which does not comply with the provisions of Motor Vehicles Act 1988 and the Rules framed thereunder shall be registered before exemption is granted by Government under Rule 334 of K.M.V. Rules, 1989 in accordance with the Overall Dimensions of Motor Vehicles (Prescription of conditions for exemption) Rules 1991 published as per notification No. GSR 583(E) of Government of India dated 12.9.1991 (Vide endt. No. CI-16929/TC/91 dated 30.10.1991).

Any deviation from the above instructions will be viewed very seriously.
