## NOTIFICATION

G.O.(P) 69/89/PW&amp;T

Dated, Trivandrum 30-4-1989.

S.R.O.No. - In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(3) of section 52 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988(Central Act 59 of 1988), the Government of Kerala hereby authorise the owners of not less than ten transport vehicles to alter any vehicle owned by them by replacing the engines of such vehicles necessitating the change of the engine number in the certificate of registration without the approval of the registering authority subject to the following conditions:-

1. The engine that is replaced should not be more than five years old than the year of manufacture of the chassis to which it is fitted; and
2. The engine replaced should be of identical make as original, and if the engine replaced is of a different make it should be of a make that is usually fitted on to a vehicle of that class.

It shall come into force on the 1st day of July, 1989.

## Explanatory Note

(This does not form a part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

The Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988), came into force on the 1st day of July, 1989. Sub-section(3) of section 52 of the Act empowers the State Government to authorise by notification in the Official Gazette, subject to such conditions as may be specified in the notification, the owners of not less than ten transport vehicles to alter any vehicle owned by them so as to replace the engine thereof without the approval of the registering authority. This notification is intended to achieve the above purpose.
