CIRCULAR NO. 39/98

Permits - Tourist Vehicles and Goods Carriages (National Permit) - Procedure for registration and grant/issue of permit - Instructions issued -

Ref: Circular No. 36/98 dated 17.10.98.

Circular No. 1/90 dated 20.1.98 and No. 45/85 dated 21.12.85.

The existing procedure for registration of tourist vehicles and goods carriages (National Permit) and issue of permits to them was evolved at a time when the number of such permits were restricted and therefore regulated by the State Transport Authority. Now that, such restrictions do not exist and permits are issued to all the eligible applicants, the existing procedure could be simplified to the advantage of the public. Therefore the following instructions are issued.

1. On receipt of a written request from the owner of the vehicle the Regional Transport Officers and Sub Regional Transport Officers will register them as tourist vehicle/ goods carriage (National Permit) as the case may be, without insisting on any reference from the State Transport Authority.
2. Endorsement for tax may be made immediately and tax collected within the time limit.
3. As soon as the vehicle is produced after complying with the relevant provisions, it may be inspected for certificate of fitness (without insisting of any reference from the State Transport Authority) and the certificate as per MV Rules, 235 (3) (Prescribed in Circular No. 1/90 dated 20.1.90) issued immediately.
4. On completion of the above steps relating to registration, payment of tax and certificate of fitness, the owner may approach the State Transport Authority with application for permit/authorisation along with the current records.
5. Applications/current records received in the State Transport Authority will be processed, decision taken immediately and the papers despatched to the applicant by registered post with A.D.

The receipt of this circular will be acknowledged and the revised procedure introduced with effect from 21.12.1998.
