Sub: Transport Vehicles - Procedure of issue of
Certificate of Fitness - prior to renewal of
permit/authorisation.

Ref: This Head Office Circular No.17/84 of June 1984.

...

The existing system of submitting application for renewal of permit/annual authorisation and obtaining certificate of fitness in respect of transport vehicles involves an elaborate procedure. When an application for renewal of permit/authorisation is submitted before the State Transport Authority/Regional Transport Authority, "sanction proceedings" are issued to enable the applicant to get the vehicle inspected for issue of Fitness Certificate.

With a view to simplify the procedure, it is decided that vehicles in respect of which application for issue/renewal of permit/authorisation have been submitted in the concerned office (STA or RTA), may be inspected for issue of Fitness Certificate, on production of "acknowledgement" (Counter receipt) instead of sanction proceedings. Para 5 of the Circular referred above stands modified to this extent.
