It has come to the notice of Government of India that the roads of the Country especially the National High Ways, largely suffer from the over loading of vehicles. The 13th report on National Highways System presented by the Committee on Transport & Tourism has also expressed their shock about the blatant violation of the law of the land and the inaction of the enforcement machinery in the matter. To make the hands of enforcing agencies strong, amendment have also been made in Section 113-115 of the M.V.Act 1988 in order to restrict the overloading of the transport vehicles.

Hence you are directed to follow the Provisions of Section 113 and 114 of M.V.Act, 1988 strictly to stop overloading of the vehicles. The over loaded vehicles should be unloaded to their allowable capacity before leaving the check-post.
