Sub:- Road Accidents in the State- Checking of Motor Vehicles for certificate of fitness- regarding.

On analysing the reports of accidents, it is revealed that the major causes of the road accidents are rash and negligent driving and bad condition of vehicles etc. It has also come to notice that certain vehicles are found to have defective performance despite being issued with Certificate of fitness.

Attention is invited to the instructions issued in Circular No.4/84. All Officers are directed to abide strictly by the instructions contained therein. There should be superchecks by the Senior Officers of the department on the fitness certification of all categories of heavy vehicles.

The Officers who issue certificate of fitness will be personally responsible for the fitness of the vehicle and in any case if a false certificate is found to have been issued the officer will automatically render himself personally liable to a major penalty including dismissal from service.

Deputy Transport Commissioners, Regional Transport Officers and Joint Regional Transport Officers will also supervise the inspection of vehicles done by Motor Vehicles Inspectors and Asst. Motor Vehicles Inspectors under their respective jurisdiction.
