Instructions issued.


Ref: This Head Office Circular No.5/84 issued in Feb.84.

-b:-

The Director General of Police has issued instructions vide his Circular No.49/98 dated 1-7-98 directing officers of Motor Transport Wing of the Police Department who possess the requisite technical qualification to inspect the vehicles involved in road accidents. In view of these instructions it is decided that officers of this Department need not ordinarily attend to this item of work. However, in the following types of cases if requisition is received from the investigating officer the vehicles may be inspected by technically qualified officers of this department not below the rank of Motor Vehicles Inspector.

- (a) Cases under section 304, 304 (A), IPC involving death of more than two persons (classified as 'grave crime' by the Police Department).
- (b) Other accidents of exceptionally serious nature
- (c) cases reported in those districts where technically qualified Police Officers are not posted at all.

Receipt of this Circular will be acknowledged. These instructions will take effect from 1-3-1998.
