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Instances have come to notice that even after the acceptance of the summons issued by the Court to the officers of this Department especially Asst. Motor Vehicle Inspectors/Motor Vehicle Inspectors of this Department to appear before the Court as a material witness in a motor accident cases attached to that Court, they failed to appear on the particular posting dates for giving evidence.

Since material witness in motor accident cases is highly required for the just decision of the cases it is directed that all officers of this Department, especially Executive Staff who accept a summons from a Court to appear before the Court as a witness for giving evidence should be present in that Court on the posting date itself. Under any circumstances if he fails to appear before the Court on the posting date he should apply for adjournment before the Court through the concerned Government Member.
