In the review report of Accountant General during
the period of 2/94 to 3/94 - National Permit scheme - it is
brought to the notice of this Department that there is no
uniformity in the maintenance of "Vehicle movement Register"
kept at various Motor Vehicles Check Posts. Accountant
General has pointed out certain other defects also to be
~~rectified~~ rectified and directed to issue instructions to
all Motor Vehicle Inspectors of Check Posts in order to
ascertain the details of vehicles passing through the
Check Posts and to identify the vehicle easily. So the
following instructions are issued to Motor Vehicles
Inspectors of Check Posts.

1. The "Vehicle Movement Registers" kept in the Check
Post should contain all the details as shown in
the proforma appended.
2. A Check Report Register also should be maintained
showing all the details of Check reports prepared.
In the Check reports relating the vehicle covered
by National Permit the details such as the period
of validity of authorisation, the period for which
composite tax due to Kerala has been paid etc.
also are to be recorded.


