Government vide reference first cited have fixed upper monitory limit for sanctioning Temporary Advance/Non Regundable Advance by different categories of officers. It has also been instructed that each department should issue an order specifying the designation of officers under his ~~asset~~ to be included under the categories mentioned in the Government Order.

The upper monitory limit fixed for various officers of Motor Vehicles Department as follows:

<u>Category</u>	<u>Nature of advance</u>	<u>Upper monitory limit</u>
1. Joint RTO	Temporary Advance/ Non Refundable Advance	Rs.50,000/-
2. RTO.	"	Rs.75,000/-
3. DTC.	"	Rs.1,00,000/-
4. Transport Commissioner	"	AS per rules without monitory limit.

The monitory limit fixed above shall be subject to GPF Rules and standing orders and delegation of powers granted to the officers.
