## CIRCULAR NO.7/95

Sub: Motor Vehicles Department - Establishment - Temporary
Registration - Delegation of Powers to the Joint RTO
(Administration) and Motor Vehicles Inspectors of
Debuty Transport Commissioners - Acceptance of Tax
(Non Transport Vehicles) and Fees etc. in the Office
of the Debuty Transport Commissioners - Detailed
instructions issued -

There has been fast increase in the vehicle population in Kerala particularly in the Cities of Thiruvananthapuram, Ernakulam, Kozhikode and Thrissur. The increase in the number of vehicles has brought considerable work load in the Regional Transport Offices especially in the area dealing with taxation and registration of vehicles. Though Sub Regional Transport Offices started functioning in Taluk levels, the work load in the Offices situated in City areas could not be reduced effectively. Besides, public who approach for services in the Offices often complain about delay in getting things done. To save time, people want services ruickly. But as a matter of fact, the Staff strength in the Offices has not been increased commensurate with the number of vehicles. In order to lessen the burden of the Staff and to avoid public grievences, it is decided to shift some of the items of work now attended to in the Urban Regional Transport Offices to the Zonal Deputy Transport Commissioner's Offices.

2. In view of the above, Temporary Certificate of Registration, acceptance of tax in respect of Non-Transport vehicles, acceptance of fees for the services in the Offices of the Department etc. now attended to in the Regional Transport Offices should be dealt with in the Zonal Deputy Transport Commissioner's Offices of the respective areas also. Hence the following quidelines are issued:

## Temporary Registration:

- 3.1. Rule 94 of K.H.V. Rules, 1989 read with Section
  43 of the M.V.Act, 1988 deals with the grant of Temporary
  Certificate of Registration. The practice hitherto follow—
  ed is that the Temporary Certificate of Registration in
  respect of a vehicle is issued by the Registering Authority
  of the respective jurisdiction. It is hereby directed that
  hereinafter the Registering Authority of Thiruvananthapuram,
  Ernakulam, Thrissuf and Kozhikode should delegate the powers
  for the grant of Temporary Certificate of Registration to the
  Joint Regional Transport Officers (Administration) and Motor
  Vehicles Inspectors attached to the Deputy Transport
  Commissioner's Office of the respective Zones; viz.
  Thiruvananthapuram, Ernakulam, Thrissum and Kozhikode.
- 3.2. The Joint Regional Transport Officers (Administration) and Motor Vehicles Inspectors of the Denuty Transport Commissioner's Offices may/grant and issue Temporary Certificate of Registration to the vehicles which are now being granted and issued in the respective Regional Transport Offices, subject to the rules and regulations governed for the purpose and as per the delegated powers under Rule 94 of K.M.V. Rules, 1989.

## Acceptance of Fees:

- 4.1. Rule 403 of K.M.V. Rules, 1989 emisages that the fees under the M.V.Act and Rules, shall be remitted to any of the State treasuries or any of the ffices of the Motor Vehicles Department where such facility is provided.
- 4.2. It is directed that fees for the services in the Offices of the Department shall also be a septed in all Deputy Transport Commissioner's Offices. The Deputy Transport Commissioners are directed that suitable arrangements should be made to accept the fees in their offices. For this purpose, a subsidiary Cash Book shall be maintained and the daily total should be brought in the Main Cash Book of the Office. All relevant rules and regulations and administrative instructions in regaration the acceptance and remittance of fees should be preserved accountedly.
