ORDER

At present the Vehicles owned by Government are not covered by any insurance scheme. If, any Government Vehicle is involved in an accident, the compensation awarded to third parties for losses sustained by them are paid from Government funds.

3. The question whether Government Vehicles should have insurance for third party risks was under consideration of Government for some time past. While examining the budget proposals for payment of compensation to motor accident victims, the VIII Subject Committee of the VIII Kerala Legislative Assembly had also recommended that all Government vehicles should be brought within third party insurance.

3. After having examined all aspects of the matter Government are pleased to order that all motor vehicles belonging to the Government of Kerala be given third party insurance cover and that the Insurance be with United India Insurance Company who have furnished proposals in this regard.

4. The expenditure on insurance premium will be debited to 'Office Expenses' of the Department/Office to which the vehicle is attached.

5. Orders on the modalities of insurance will issue separately.
