Sub: - M.Vs.Dept. Inadequate action to collect compounding fee imposed on the registered owners of Motor Vehicles based on check reports -

Ref: - Lr.No.SRA (HO)IV/MVT/22-501/90-91 dtd. 8.8.1990 of A.G., Thiruvagantha uram.

The Accountant General while inspecting the accounts of Joint Regional Transport Office, Irinjalakkuda for the year 1989-90 has pointed out that a good number of check reports in respect of which compounding fee was leviable, were pending disposal and in a large number of cases, first charge memo above was seen issued and no follow-up action had been taken so far. Inadequate action in levying the compounding fee affects Government revenue adversely.

There is now provision in the Central Motor Vehicle Rules 1989 in regard to the clearance of tax and compounding fee. As per rule 73 of the C.M.V. Rules, 1989, no authorised testing station shall accept an application for grant or renewed of a C.F. unless the same is accompanied by a tax clearance certificate in such form as may be prescribed by the State Government from the Regional Transport Officer or Motor Vehicles Inspector having jurisdiction in the area to the effect that the vehicle is not in arrears of Motor Vehicles tax or any compounding fee referred to in sub sections (5) and (6) of section 86 of the M.V.Act, 1988. In the absence of any authorised testing station at present, field staff are conducting the test of all transport vehicles for issuing certificate of fitness. As such, the said provisions of Central Rules, 1989 are to be enforced by the field staff and the payment of arrears of tax or compounding fee insisted by them before inspecting the vehicles for the issue of C.F.

All Regional Transport Officers and Joint Regional Trans... port Officers are directed to comply with the above instructions when vehicles are produced for C.F. test. The receipt of this circular should be acknowledged.
