Sub: M.Vs. Issue of temporary permit to Private
buses - instructions - reg-

Ref: Letter dt.16.8.94 from the Honourable Minister
for Transports.

It has come to notice from authentic sources that the temporary permits which were issued by the respective Regional Transport Authorities in the State allowing private vehicles to operate through nationalised routes, are now being questioned by the Public Undertaking (K.S.R.T.C.) as per section 104 of the M.V.Act. Reports also indicate that such permits are being transferred to some other operators with the consent of the previous permit holders. It is also received reports that the Regional Transport Authorities of Palakkad and Trissur have already transferred such permits in question. The issue of such permits itself is irregular in the absence of No objection certificate from the K.S.R.T.C. The K.S.R.T.C. has requested the Regional Transport Authorities to cancel such permits which are pending before the Regional Transport Authorities. Transfer of temporary permits issued under sec. 104 of the M.V.Act is highly irregular. Hence all R.T.Cs are directed not to proceed with the transfer of such permits to any other operators. The requests received from the previous owners for transferring the permits may be withheld till a final classification is issued by the Government. The lapse on the part of the Officers in the R.T.Os has to be viewed very seriously. The receipt of the letter should be acknowledged.
