A number of posts of Motor Vehicles Inspectors, Assistant Motor Vehicles Inspectors and peons were sanctioned by the Government from time to time for manning various Check Posts in the state under this department. Of these posts, all assistant Motor Vehicles Inspectors and Peons are treated as attached to the office of the Regional Transport Officer where as some of the Motor Vehicle Inspectors continue to be head quartered at the location of the Check Posts.

It is now found that this arrangement in respect of the MVIs. leads to serious inconvenience in detailing them for duty in various Check Posts by rotation. It also caused hardship to the MVIs as most of the Check Posts are located at remote places with inconveniences such as lack of proper office building, non -availability of family accommodation, non-applicability of house rent allowance, absence of sub treasury etc. With a view to overcome these administrative inconvenience and to minimise hardship to individual officers, it is ordered that as in the case of AMVIs and Peons, all posts of MVIs meant for manning the Check Posts in a district will be treated as attached to the office of the Regional Transport Officer of the concerned district with immediate effect.
