At present, posting of Assistant Motor Vehicle Inspectors in the checkposts is done by the Regional Transport Officers concerned in whose jurisdiction the border checkposts are situated, from among the Assistant Motor Vehicle Inspectors in the R.T.Office, limiting the period of duty to six months. It has come to notice that Assistant Motor Vehicle Inspectors who manage to get posting in the checkposts for a considerable period will not get himself acquainted with circle work and enforcement work. Taxation work and enforcement work are therefore seen neglected and arrears of tax mounting quarter after quarter. In some of the officers, amount of arrears pending under service verification is more than 50% and even 100%.

In order to overcome this contingency, it is to be ensured that AMVIs get more time for circle work and they be stow their attention for checking of vehicles. Without proper enforcement of M.V. Act and Rules, accidents and traffic offences cannot be checked and image of the department can not be improved. Moreover arrears of tax accumulated for years is to be reduced considerably and defaulters booked then and there. More revenue is also to be mobilised by way of compounding fee.

It is hereby instructed that to overcome the above situation, AMVIs in the entire zone is to be posted to the checkposts under the zone on rotation basis for a period of ten to fifteen days. The powers to post AMVIs in the Checkpost will be exercised by the Zonal Deputy Transport Commissioners concerned. By this arrangement the office work and enforcement work can be done in a better way.

These instructions will come in to force with effect from 1.10.97 onwards. The experience of this system will be monitored and reviewed after 3 months. Receipt of the circular will be acknowledged.
