The Kozhikode District Lorry Owners' Association in their letter dated 10-3-69 addressed to the Mini to Foot Transport has represented among other things, that lorry owners are charged even for negligible overloads. The addressated in the representation that the Association is all along discouraging its members in taking overloads in accordingly vehicles, but the goods taken in the vehicles accordingly to the best knowledge and estimate of the drivers may at times, vary beyond the permitted laden weight as the weight of equal lots of goods like timber, firewood etc. she half varies according to their quality. The Association therefore requests to allow a little margin in the permitted laden weight for goods vehicles as such slight overloads are not intentional.

The various aspects of the above request of the Association have been examined in detail. It is felt remained to allow 5% marginal adjustment over and above the permited laden weight of goods vehicles. This is being done in Madras State also. In the circumstances, you are requested to see that overloads not exceedings 5% of the PUN of goods vehicles are not noted as an offence by the checking officers. Cases of overloads already pending with you may be disposed of in the light of these instructions.
