Consequent on the implementation of the M.V. Act 1988 and the Central Motor Vehicle Rules 1989, Tourist Vehicle permits to motor cabs are being issued under section 88(9) of the M.V. Act read with Rule 83 of the C.M.V. Rules, 1989. Further, these permits are issued based on the condition that fees or tax due to other State if any shall be paid. Accordingly the officers at the Check Post and other field staff in the other states are realizing tax from Tourist Motor cabs (permits issued by this authority) of our State while plying in other States.

All the M.V.Is & A.M.V.Is in the Check Post and other executive staff of this Department are therefore requested to keep an eye to watch the operation of Tourist motor cabs of other States to this State and collect the tax due to this State at the rate applicable and issue receipts. Moreover the Heads of Offices should forward a statement showing the total amount collected every month in this respect to this office not later than 10<sup>th</sup> month of every month in this respect to this office not later than 10<sup>th</sup> of every month commencing from October 1990. The M.V.Is in the check posts should forward it directly to this office so as to avoid delay in re-transmission of the report by the offices to which they are attached.
