Agenda: To consider the proposal for imposition of age limit to interstate Contract Carriage and also goods carriages as follow up action on the decision on item No.18 of the meeting of the 18th meeting of the Transport Ministers, Transport Secretaries and Transport Commissioners of Southern States.

No. D1/PS 18/2003/STA

Decision:

It is seen that many of the Contract Carriages covered by regular permit, especially operating on inter-state routes are old. Permit is being renewed irrespective of the age of the vehicle and without replacing the vehicle. Interstate Contract Carriages cover long distances and usually run at high speed and causes fatal accidents. The same is the case with Goods Carriages operating interstate also. Transport Authority, Kerala, direct that no permit shall be granted, renewed, countersigned or validity extended with effect from 1st September 2006 to any transport vehicles operating interstate which have attained the age of 15 years from the date of registration.
