Your immediate attention is invited to the referen cited. Vide reference second cited, you were directed to ensure, that Rule 282(1) of KMV Rules, 1989 are strictly enforced in respect of all Stage Carriages operating within your jurisdiction. But many complaints are still being received from the Public. Hence you are directed to cancel the CF of Stage Carriages of which the footboard is above the limit prescribed tt/R 282 (1) of KMV Rules, 1989, which specifies that the height of the lowest step for any entrace or exis shall not be more than forty cm or less than 25 cm above the ground when the vehicle is empty. As per order No. C1/889/TC/99 dated5.3.99 the height of the second and subsequent steps, which will be provided in the public Service Vehicles shall not exceed 30 cms.

please adhere to the instructions scrupulosly and take stringent action against the violation of the above rules including the cancellation of CF of the vehicles.
