Abstract

Students Travel Concession in Private Buses--Guidelines prescribed--Orders issued.

ORDER

Regular students and students undergoing Private studies in Universities in Kerala are eligible for fare at concessional reates in city, town and ordinary services as per para G of fare revision notifications issued by Covernment.

- 2. Prepaid concession tickets are being issued by Kerala State Road Transport Corporation, on the basis of the Identity cards issued by the Headsof recognised Educational Institutions.
- 3. In the case of Students who travel in Private Bus Government have given certain direction for grant of collession tickets as per Government order read as 1st paper.
- 4. Several representations have been received from private bus operators alleging that the identity cards issued by the head of institution are being misused causing head loss to the operators. They have also complained that careful persons travel without Identity cards in the guise of structus and it from a Bus operators to loss. They therefore requested Government to introduce the Identity cards system more affactively, preventing any likely misuse of student concession, So that growing students are facilitated and misuse prevented.
- Openation of the examined the matter in detail in concultation with the representatives of the Private Huses and constituted a Student Travel Pacility Committee in each District under the Chairmenship or District Oplicator for takling the travel problems of students as per Government order 3rd read. Government also decided to issue identity/concession cards to students through the Atulant Travel Facility Committee and prescribed the following guidalines.
 - (1) Regional Transport Officer will be the Convener of the Budent Travel Pacility Committee.
 - (2) The Student Travel Facility Committee of each district will meet immediately and will arrange the printing of sufficient No. of Identity/concession cards through sponsorship of agencies in the Form appended to this Government Order.

- (3) The Committee through Convener or authorised representative/s will entrust the printed cards to the Hoods of Educational Institutions which in turn will be distributed to the students who are desirous of availing travel concession.
 - (4) The students will return the cards duly filled up to the Heads of Educational Institutions who in turn return it with his signature to the Convener of the Student Travel Facility Committee Viz.

 Regional Transport Officer.
- (5) The students undergoing private studies for a recognised course of the University should affix photograph on the space provided for and should produce relevant proof of study such as provious marklist/certificate/acknowledgement issued by University etc.
 - (6) The Convener of the Committee after verification of the information furnished by students with respect to the documents produced by them will issue concession cards duly countersigned.
 - 7) Each student will be permitted two journeys per day and they will produce the identity card before the Conductor while travelling in Bus and demanding concession in fare.
 - concession in fare in Private buses will be allowed to students skrictly on production of Identity/ concession cords issued by the Student Travel Proility Conveittee.
 - (9) The students registering their name for private study in Universities in Kerela will enclose an acknowledgement card also with the application and the University will return the acknowledgement card to the registrants after affixing their seal.
 - (10) Higher Education Department will issue necessary directions to the Universities in this regard.
 - (11) The students will produce the acknowledgement card before the Conventry of the Student Travel Facility Committee as soon as it is received from the University.
