NOTIFICATION

G. O. (B) No. 12/56 Transport, dated Trichayram, 28th August 1956.
S. R. O. No. 108/56.—Where representations have been received by the Government of Kerala that the procedure for grant of concession tickets to students who are made eligible for concessional fares as per para G (b) of the Notification G. O. (B) No. 112/51/TF & P dated the 1st December, 1951, published as S. R. O. No. 1417/51 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 264 dated the 1st December, 1951, should be prescribed:

And whereas the Government of Kerala are satisfied that it is necessary in prescribing the procedure to be followed in the matter of grant of concession tickets to the students mentioned in para G (b) of the said notification and to issue directions to the State Transport Authority to be the area to be covered from such students:

And whereas the Government of Kerala have published the details of the directions proposed to be issued to the State Transport Authority in this regard as S. R. O. No. 108/56/TF & P dated the 28th August, 1956 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 1028 dated

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) and (3) of section 10 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1939 (Central Act 4 of 1939) and in implementation of the directions published under Notification No. M.T.S. 111/1939, dated the 13th July, 1939, in the Kerala Gazette No. 41 dated the 1st October, 1939, the Government of Kerala hereby issues the following directions to the State Transport Authority, hereinafter, in consultation with the State Transport Authority, all the objections and suggestions received in response to the said draft and after giving the representatives of the interest affected an opportunity of being heard as required by the proviso to subsection (3) of the said section, to-wit:—

Direction

The State Transport Authority shall fix the rate of fare inclusive of tax on passengers that can be realised from the full-time student specified in para 12 (B) of the Notification No. G. O. M. 111/39/TP & F dated the 1st December, 1939, published as S. R. O. No. 1447/31 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 292 dated the 1st December, 1939, subject to the following further conditions and procedure to be satisfied by the student:

Conditions

Such students shall be entitled to the concession only for travels to and fro between 7.00 a. m. and 7.00 p. m. for attending classes and only if they show an identity card issued from the concerned University of the following form:—

Explanatory Note

This is not part of the Notification, but is to indicate its effect (for purpose).

There have been several complaints to Government to the effect that the bus travel concession allowed to the Private Students are being misused.

The private registered student is required to file along with application form an identification card in the form given and to be filled in case with his photograph before the University and one copy of the identification card is returned to the student concerned duly signed by the University. It is felt that the identification card thus issued by the University can be used to prevent any likely misuse of the student concession. This notification is intended to give effect to this procedure.
