Attention is invited to the above references. Vide reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited, the Central Government had specified maximum Gross Vehicle Weight and maximum Safe Axle Weight. Now vide reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited, the Government had amended the above said notification by incorporating "2 axle Passenger Vehicle with Air Suspension Two tyres on front axle and Four tyres on rear axle" specifying maximum Gross Vehicle Weight as 18.0 tonnes with 6.5 tonnes on Front Axle and 11.5 tonnes on Rear Axle. As per this notification the tolerance upto five percent in the Gross Vehicle Weight and Safe axle weight as specified in the notifications may be allowed for the purpose of compliance to Sub-section (3) of Section 113 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988). All are directed to implement the notification without fail. Copy of the notification 1<sup>st</sup> referred is enclosed herewith for ready reference.
