Sub: Motor Vehicles Department - M G P Initiative No.II 3.5.8.1 -
Safety considerations in Road Transport - Implementation of
Sub activity - Setting up of Road Safety Club in Schools/Colleges- regarding.

Ref: This office letter of even No. dated 24.6.2005

Government have accorded sanction for the implementations of
Departmental Initiative proposed under the "Modernizing Government
Programmes" viz.. Safety considerations in Road Transport.

One among the Activities proposed is "Conduct of Awareness
Campaigns". 'Setting up of Road Safety Clubs' in Schools/Colleges is one
sub activity under the said Activity. The Road Safety Clubs are intended
for involving Student community in road safety activities and to create
awareness on road use. The proposal is to set up one Road Safety Club in
selected Schools/Colleges in the jurisdiction of each office. RT Offices
Thiruvananthapuram, Ernakulam and Kozhikode has to set up three
additional clubs in their jurisdiction in view of the higher population in the
cities. The Department will provide an amount of Rs.10,000/- to each club
for the initial expenditure for setting up of the Club i.e. to set up office for
the Club in the Institution concerned, purchase of furniture, stationery
expenses connected with the inauguration of the club etc..

A copy of the draft Byelaw of the 'Road Safety Clubs' is enclosed herewith.
You are requested to identify one school/college under the jurisdiction of
each office, which are interested in road safety activities and to set up the

Clubs as per the Byelaw. The Regional Transport Officers Thiruvananthapuram, Ernakulam and Kottikode may set up 3 clubs additionally in view of the higher population in these cities. Preference should be given to those Schools/Colleges which have contributed to the cause of Road Safety previously. Further you are informed that an amount of Rs.10,000 (Rs. Ten thousand only) for initial expenditure will be made available shortly and additional working fund amounting to Rs.15,000/- will be disbursed as soon as detailed proposal for awareness programme by the Club are received. You are directed to nominate a Nodal Officer preferably one Motor Vehicles Inspector or Assistant Motor Vehicles Inspector to carry out the Activity successfully during the financial year.


The Deputy Transport Commissioners in the respective zones are directed to closely monitor the progress and report.
