Sub activity – Setting up of Road Safety Club - allotment
of funds – sanctioned – Orders issued.

ORDER NO.MITI/1583/TC/2004/3.5.8.1 dated 18.01.08.

Government have accorded sanction for the implementations of
Departmental Initiative proposed under the “Modernizing Government
Programmes” viz.. Safety considerations in Road Transport.

One among the Activities proposed is ‘Conduct of Awareness
Campaigns’. ‘Setting up of Road Safety Clubs’ in Schools/Colleges is one
sub activity under the said Activity. The Road Safety Clubs are intended
for involving Student community in Road Safety activities and to create
awareness on Road use. The proposal is to set up Road Safety Clubs one
each under the jurisdiction of each office of the Joint Regional Transport
Offier of the SRT Offices and Regional Transport Officers of the RT
Offices,except RTO(NS).. Additional 9 Clubs 3 each under the jurisdiction
of Regional Transport Officers Thiruvananthapuram, Ernakulam and
Kohikode are to be set up in view of the higher population in these cities.
The Department will provide to each club an amount of Rs.10,000/- for the
initial expenditure for setting up of the Club i.e. to set up office for the Club
in the Institution concerned, purchase of furniture, stationery expenses
connected with the inauguration of the club etc.. Besides, each Club will be
provided with working fund amounting to Rs.15000/-(Rs .Fifteen thousand
only) for the effective functioning.

In the circumstances, sanction is accorded to form 68 Road Safety
Clubs in selected Schools/Colleges under the jurisdiction of the Joint
Regional Transport Officers of SRT Offices and the Regional Transport
Officers of the RT Offices,except RTO (NS). Sanction is also accorded for
drawal of Rs.6,80,000/-(Rs. Six Lakhs Eighty Thousand only) from the
Head of Account “ 3055-Road Transport - 004 – Research – 96 – Safety
Considerations in Road Transport under MGP” for the initial expenses. The

Accounts Officer is directed to draw Rs.6,80,000/- (Rs. Six Lakhs Eighty Thousand only) from the above Head of Account in cash and disburse the amount at the rate of Rs.10,000/- (Rs. Ten Thousand only) to each Regional Transport Officer, Joint Regional Transport Officer as ordered in the para above under proper acknowledgement.

The Regional Transport Officers and Joint Regional Transport Officers concerned are directed to collect the amount from the Head Quarters and make arrangements to pay the amount to the President and Secretary of the Road Safety Club formed in each School/College. They will also see that the amount thus received is deposited in the bank account opened in any scheduled bank in the vicinity of the Institution. The account will be operated jointly by the President and Secretary of the Club as per the Byelaw (draft) framed. 
