Vide reference cited the Government have informed that
on a Vigilance enquiry it is revealed that one Shri.R. Murali,
T.C.12/221, Thodiyil veedu, Pattoor, Thiruvananthapuram managed
to get the hypothecation of a vehicle cancelled by the Regional
Transport Officer, Thiruvananthapuram on the basis of a forged
letter head of Kerala Financial Corporation and forged signature
and official seal of District Manager, Kerala Financial Corporat-
ion. In the light of the above instance the vigilance Department
has requested to issue necessary instruction to the Registering
Authorities in the State to be vigilant against the occurrence
of such cases.

Therefore all the Regional Transport Officers and
Joint Regional Transport Officers are requested for ensuring
strict verification regarding the genuinness of the letter
received from various financial agencies with whom motor
vehicles are pledged, before cancelling the hypothecation
endorsements. Receipt of this letter should be acknowledged.
