IV. - cars used as taxis - restriction on de-registration regarding.

By the references first cited Government of India have restricted de-registration of motor cars for a period of 3 years from the date of their first registration as taxis.

Govt. of India have clarified again that the restriction on de-registration applied to those taxis which enjoyed excise rebate allowed at the time of purchase as they were to be used as taxis. It is also pointed that the de-registration can be enforced by imposing it at the time of registration as taxi.

Hence all regional Transport Officers are requested to make a note both in the registration certificate and 'A' register of such vehicles which have enjoyed excise rebate, at the time registration to the effect that "the vehicle should not be de-registered as car within 3 years of its registration."
