A facility for selecting date for the driving test by the candidate himself is available in our website for the last two years. One driving test ground was fixed for each RTOffice\Sub RT Office. But more than one testing ground is allotted in some of the offices at a distant place other than the main ground allotted to that office.

Driving license test date management system have a facility to show the details of testing ground under each office. But due to some technical reasons, facility for setting the test ground could not published in the website. Now the STQC auditing of the module is completed and published in the website under employee login.

Each head of the office has to login to their employee login. Set the Testing ground against each day of test. For eg if in Attingal RTOffice,

driving test is conducted at Mamom on Monday, Thrursday and Saturday and at Varkala on Tuesday and Friday. So Mamom has to be entered against Monday, Thursday and Saturday and Varkala has to be entered against Tuesday and Friday.

After entering the details of the Ground the candidates will be able to chose a test date according to the Ground. This will eliminate the difficulties faced by the candidates where more than one ground is allotted for driving test.

All the Head of offices are requested to read the User Manual shown below and set the details of ground in the web page
